## Directions to Robbinsville Community Park:

GPS users: Address 15 West Manor Way, Trenton, NJ 08691

PLEASE READ - The New Jersey Turnpike Authority is widening the highway. As a result several bridges in the area of Robbinsville Community Park are closed. For those coming South on Route 130 you should have no issues and continue to make a left on Gordon Road and travel 1 mile and look for field parking across the street from the Park (next to the Cemetery). If you are coming from Route 195 and exit at Route 526 the Bridge on West Manor way is closed. As a result please exit at Route 130 north and travel ~ 1/2 mile and exit right at Sharon Road. Take Sharon Road 1 mile and make a right on Gordon Road. Parking will be on your left across from the fields.

## **DIRECTIONS-**

<u>From the east:</u> Take Route 195 west to ROUTE 130 NORTH. TAKE 130 N FOR 1/2 MILE AND MAKE A RIGHT AT SHARON ROAD. TAKE SHARON 1 MILE AND MAKE A RIGHT AT GORDON. PARKING IS ON THE LEFT ACROSS FROM THE PARK.

From the west: Same as above except take Route 195 East.

<u>From the north or south:</u> Take the NJ Turnpike to exit 7A. After the toll booth bear right onto Route 195 West. Get off at the Route 130 North -follow same direction above.

From Route 206: Proceed south on route 206 to Nassau St. in Princeton and turn left. Stay on Nassau to Route 571 and turn right (Washington Road). Follow Rt. 571 across Rt. 1. Beginning with and counting the light at Rt1 you will go to your 5th light and turn right onto Rt. 526. Follow Rt. 526 to light (Village Rd & Edinburg Rd) to end. Make right turn onto Old Trenton Rd still Rt. 526. Go 100 yards and turn left onto Edinburg Rd still Rt. 526. Following Rt. 526 for 1/2 mile and make a left on Meadowbrook Rd. Take to end ( you will pass lacrosse fields - we are not playing here ). Cross Rt 130 and continue on Gordon Road. Take Gordon Road for 1 mile and look for field parking across from the park on the left.

**Parking:** Parking rules must be followed. Park only in designated areas. Police will ticket illegally parked vehicles. The Princeton Cemetery will have cars towed if parked on or in front of their property. The Robbinsville Lacrosse Association (RLA) will have volunteers and local Police to direct drivers to designated parking locations. Your cooperation is appreciated. The main parking area is a grass field across from our lacrosse fields.

Parking at the Gordon Road entrance to Community Park is for officials, tournament officials and the Handicapped (must display proper signage) only. You can use this area for drop off but cars parked illegally will be ticketed.

**BBQ grilling:** RLA has obtained a special permit for grilling. **No other grilling on Community Parks ground is permitted.** This includes the parking areas as well. Please inform your parents not to bring them.

**Concessions**: We will be serving a great menu of hot and cold foods throughout the day. Also, our food concession will have fresh Philly pretzels, homemade baked goods, hot and cold drinks, snacks and other items. The RLA will be selling 2013 Robbinsville Shootout t-shirts that include each participating program's name on the back. A limited supply is available on a first come first served basis. Your support of the Shootout is appreciated. A vendor will be onsite selling lax items and stringing sticks.

**Weather** - In the event of inclement weather, a decision will be made by no later than 6:30am to postpone. Coaches, coordinators and referees will be notified by email or cell phone. Sunday, May 19 is the rain date.
